Is it a problem if we just have something to drink? We are having a bit of a difficulty to decide on our main course. We would like to start with the chicken soup and then decide about our main course.
Well, the lasagna is very popular. I'd suggest the spareribs or the chop suey. You can call me when you're ready to order. Please, call me when you're ready to order. Maybe you would like something to drink while you're waiting? Not at all. Feel free. If you sit at the bar, it is no problem. Well, this is a restaurant. We need our tables for people who come to have dinner. And you? And for you?	Yes, I would like the lasagna, please. I think I'll have the ... Oh, goodbye then. Well, we'll sit there then.

Would you like your steak rare, medium or well done?	Rare, please. I prefer medium. I would like mine well done, please.

¹strangely, in the USA, **entrée** is the word commonly used for the main course of a meal; in other countries it is used to indicate a small dish eaten before the main course, thus a synonym for **starter**.

²**still water** is an uncommon synonym for **flat water**
